LEGACY DEVOTIONAL (before lunch)

LUNCH

At Legacy we eat together as families either in the gym area or outside. Pizza is available for purchase during lunch for those who would like. Each person will receive 2 slices of pizza and salad for only \$2.

LEGACY ACTIVITIES

Legacy has optional activities for the whole family outside of co-op day that are planned by parents and Navigators. They vary from year to year depending on the needs of members. Some of these activities may include, mom's night, Navigator activities, park days, family socials etc. During co-op day, as members we may decide to have a short party during co-op to celebrate holidays such as Valentines Day or Halloween/Fall Harvest.

CALENDAR

Our school year begins the first Monday after Labor Day in September. Fall Semester ends after the first Monday in December. Spring semester begins the first Monday in January and ends the middle of April. We take Spring Break off.
